

CUC 2007 and Summer Series Update

Team Deposits Deadline Extended to June 12

Teams which intend to compete at the Canadian Ultimate Championships in Toronto August 9-12, 2007 ("CUC 2007") are required to send a \$500 deposit cheque to CUPA. Over 80 teams have submitted their deposits to date with some yet to do so. CUPA has extended the deadline by when teams' deposits are to be received to **Tuesday, June 12, 2007**.

The deposit cheques are to be held by CUPA, and not negotiated, pending their team's qualification for CUC 2007 and payment of all CUC players' fees. A cheque provided on behalf of a team will only be negotiated should the team qualify for CUC 2007 and then not attend or should all of the team's players' fees not be paid. The cheque will be otherwise returned.

The \$500 deposit cheques should be made payable to CUPA and mailed to John Harris, CUPA Executive Director, 30 Marlow Avenue, Toronto, Ontario M4J 3T9. Please indicate your team's name, division and region on the front of the cheque. Please again note the June 12 deadline.

Team Bid Allocations and Process Following Team Deposits Deadline

Following the June 12, 2007 team deposits deadline, CUPA will review the numbers of teams which have submitted deposits for each division in the various regions as compared with the regional allocations including wildcards to determine which teams have qualified for CUC 2007 and those which need to qualify such as by a regional competition. Teams will then be allowed to register as noted below. Registered teams will be able to roster players from the list of current CUPA members.

CUPA Membership Registration is Now Open

Players who intend to compete with a team at CUC 2007 or at a CUC regional tournament must be current members of CUPA. 2007 CUPA membership fees are to remain the same as last year at \$25. Registration is now open at the Membership link at www.canadianultimate.com.

Team and Player Registrations to Open by June 14, 2007

Players' fees with taxes will be slightly lower this year at \$100 plus 6% GST = \$106.

Junior players' fees with taxes will also be slightly lower at \$70 plus 6% GST = \$74.20.

Fee Deadlines

Teams participating in a regional tournament must submit their rosters at the start of the tournament. Only players listed on a team's roster may play with the team at a regional tournament.

Teams attending CUC 2007 from regions which do not have regional tournaments for their division must submit their rosters, along with CUPA fees and player fees, no later than July 31. All fees are then due.

Late Penalties

CUPA's fees will be increased by 25% at 9 a.m. on July 19, 2007.
